Flagship Community Programs

Unsettled turbulence and a saga of compassion

The first cases of COVID-19 in India were reported on 30 January 2020 and took us through a never-before crisis both economically and socially. Despite lock-down, daily cases peaked by mid-September with over 90,000 cases per-day and dropped to below 15,000 by January 2021 giving a ray of hope. A consistent rise in the service utilization trends was observed in all the rural clinics. This indeed motivated Team VDC to increase the outreach programs, even more, to cater to remote areas with all precautionary measures in place. However, by the end of the first quarter, the situation started going out of control across the globe. This came as an alarm and forced us to rethink the year's plan in the interest of the safety of all the stakeholders.

In dentistry, consistent exposure to body fluids, such as blood and saliva, during treatments is very frequent. Due to this, the oral healthcare sector experienced a peculiar crisis because dental-care workers operate very close to the patient's mouth and are at high risk of contamination. This mandated stringent safety measures and treatment protocols. Based on the experience from the first wave, team VDC strengthened the overall healthcare services with all necessary procedures to ensure optimal safety of both patients and the dental team. Thus, VDC managed to provide continuous low-cost quality care with uncompromising safety even at the height of the pandemic. However, **various unexpected factors posed the next level of challenges.**

Accessibility amidst Scarcity: In the public healthcare model, dentists are available at Community Health Centre (CHC) level were also actively engaged in COVID control activities. On the other hand, private dental practitioners already closed practice due to the professional and personal risks. This increased the accessibility gaps even wider. However, as our Rural Satellite Clinics functioned continuously, people with dental care needs to be visited even from places beyond the clinic's catchment area.

Retaining Compassion: Lock-down caused an interruption in healthcare for people with non-COVID conditions including dental care. "we were very happy to have support from our rural dentists and supporting staff. They wholeheartedly came forward to provide dental care services to people amidst the panic. However, it wasn't very smooth. We had challenges in sustaining their spirits" says Dr. Ramesh (Public Health Dentist, VDC). Many people who visited our clinics were not open and cooperative to share about their/ their family's medical and travel history fearing they would be denied the urgently needed treatments.

"A patient was coughing and displayed symptoms of a cold. Still, the patient said 'No' to my questions about symptoms.. Very soon, I realized having a patient triage protocol isn't enough. I figured out that we need out-of-the-box communication strategies to make them feel safe to reveal themselves. That part was very challenging.." said Dr. Kartheek (Clinic-Incharge, Siddhantam Rural Satellite Clinic)

Sustaining the services: The costs of personal protective equipment had skyrocketed. The biggest challenges for dental practitioners are that they need to compensate losses incurred due to the COVID pandemic and also, had to cope with a steep increase in recurring costs. As a result, there was a sharp rise in treatment charges. In this situation, our rural satellite clinics played a very significant role in providing affordable dental care services. During the peak months, all public transportation had come to a halt followed by curfews and time restrictions on public and private transport. Reaching the clinics and being able to commute back homes had been a nightmare for the Rural Dentists. Providing support services such as supplies, consultants had also been very challenging for the team at the Tertiary Care center in Bhimavaram.

Despite all the above-mentioned hiccups, we are proud of the spirit with which the entire field team of rural dentists and supporting staff managed to provide uninterrupted dental care services to the rural population across all our Satellite Clinics





Kumudavalli

Est Year: 2011

The clinic is located in B V Raju Knowledge Centre, Kumudavalli. It provides dental screening and referral services to children from 25 Government schools who visit BVR Knowledge Centre to access learning labs.

From Dec 2021, the clinic started providing all dental care services to local villagers as well as operating like all other Rural satellite clinics.

Dirusumarru

The clinic served till 2019 and is brought back to function in 2021 after first COVID wave, served about 385 patients performing 579 procedures. Due to change in demographic indicators, the clinic is proposed to be shifted to neighborhood community in 2022.

Located in Kalla Mandal, WG District; the clinic is established with support from Sri Vinoda Rajakumar. Since its inception, the clinic served about **8,536 patients performing 12,191 procedures.**


Rural Satellite Clinic, Antarvedipalem A case study

Antarvedipalem is a very remote area where agriculture and fishing is the major livelihood. VDC rural clinics are typically established in large villages with accessibility to about 50000-60000 population from surrounding villages. Antarvedipalem was an exception because it is a small village with poor transportation facilities. Still, considering the critical need and poor economic status of villagers, VDC established a rural clinic in 2018 targeting farming and nearby coastal fishing communities. In the first year, the clinic proved to be resourceful for the villagers. During COVID-19's first wave, when all other private dental care services were closed, people from even farther places started visiting the clinic expanding the service area. The gritty and compassionate team provided uninterrupted services in spite of all the challenges resulting in enhanced goodwill from even farther places.


In 2021, during the second wave, even when the other clinics in nearby towns restarted their operations, the patient flow in Antarvedipalem continued to grow - resulting in an 80% increase in patient flow compared to 2020 and a 52% increase from 2019 pre-COVID days.





Rural clinics focus on serving the rural population. We noticed patients from the upper-middle class also started visiting rural clinics. Based on this, VDC decided to establish semi-urban clinics in towns. This pilot initiative targets to serve upper-middle-class communities.







In 2021, VDC got associated with ISB - Experiential Learning Module (ELM). The program aims to engage management students in grassroots problem-solving. A 4 member group of management students from the Indian School of Business (ISB) ideated the project 'Enhancing productivity in Rural Satellite Clinics' and proposed a set of recommendations.



VDC joined as an institutional member in the EHAC consortium in 2020. We interact with peer individual and institutional members to brainstorm solutions for rural healthcare needs. We keep exploring the scope for collaboration.



PRIMARY CARE

OUTREACH PROGRAMS

The 5 Flagship Primary oral healthcare programs aligned to "Oral Healthcare for all" focusing on different target groups, designed to engage BDS students from all years under the able supervision of faculty to enhance their socio-humanistic skills that contribute to a transformative experience. Due to COVID's second wave, the outreach programs happened for only five months; and were stopped from April to Oct 2021.

Miles for Smiles

It is a door-to-door awareness program to screen and educate rural households on their oral health status. Since the launch, the program reached out to **87,646 people through 126 camps.**

Screening and Treatment Camps

The program conducts free dental camps in remote rural and tribal areas, providing screening, treatment, education, and referral services through Mobile Dental Unit. Since the launch, the program reached out to 1,35,561 people through 933 screening and treatment camps

Suraksha

Inspired by Auroville Dental Clinic, Pondicherry, the program takes preventive dental care treatments to children right to the doorsteps of their schools. Since the launch, the program reached out to 9379 children saving 14,476 teeth.

Pratham

The program aims to educate, enable and empower the frontline healthcare workforce on Oral health care. After a temporary pause due to COVID 19, the program got reinitiated in December 2021. Since the launch, the program reached out to **341 frontline workers** through **14 Sessions**.

Project 100 Smiles

The program intends to provide free dentures to poor support-less senior citizens who lost their teeth. In 2019, the program reached out to **70 beneficiaries**. In 2021, the program was on hold as senior citizens are at high risk of infection amidst COVID.
